I began with what I see around me, what my world is made of and it is very simple and easy to understand. It is exactly what we see and feel. So, who and what am I? Simple ...I am a human being because I am conscious, able to be aware and comprehend and relate with nature and other human beings. I have a name, a family and a personal living space. No one can say that I don't exist. We all exist because we relate with each other through our senses, therefore we know each other. In all of nature, I've never seen an example of anything relating to the reincarnation idea. Through time, everything on earth changes and is recycled through chemical processes, but it is all in relation to the elements of earth. I see our birth here as it is in nature. Just as the animals, our individual self didn't exist before we were born, because we were part of the Spirit of the Creator. That's why we don't remember anything. Not because we have memory wipes and keep becoming somebody else over and over. Our Creator made an amazing world and designed it for us to enjoy. He wants nothing from us but our love, and to honor Him for His gift of life and follow his rules of the best way to live our lives in a friendly and sharing way with others.

When we look at our world, we my tend to see all the bad things the media makes so obvious and overlook the many friendly and kind people who are everywhere. We don't notice the good things because we are in such a hurry. Not enough time and too much to do. We're caught in a busyness cycle to outwit time but it can't be done. Time is always right around the corner waiting for us to catch up ...so anymore, we don't know very many people past our family and work associates. We may not even know the neighbor living next door in our apartment building

Common sense and simplicity tells us to get back to real relationship with others and get to know the Creator personally instead of trying to figure out what He is by everyone else's ideas.

Computers



We wonder, what is our world...a real physical place or a digital simulation or something else? I was wondering for awhile because there seemed to be some interesting possibilities in the simulation idea. So I thought, Could our world really be veiled over by a dark evil matrix? Could this technology become so sophisticated as to

make us believe we are real within it? With chips in our brains and the enticements of many metaverse levels, will we forget the Creator and the true physical world and find eveything we could possibly desire in a false digital illusion? Even our physical friends and loved ones as well as ourselves could be replaced with very real-appearing robotic people who we program ourselves how we want them to be. I can imagine many bodies, lying on their couches in tiny apartments, waking up out of the dream to eat, use the bathroom and get back in to their surreal metaverses as soon as possible. Maybe the belief that our body and identity is not real and our world is not real is just another psyop to prepare us for the psuedo-reality of the metaverse.

No matter how much we want it to be true, digital objects and their components will never become viable, living entities like we are. They are

artificially made with artificial parts and they are not organic and can never be organic. Just like a fish can never live outside its watery domain, digital must stay in its mechanical and digital dimension and so must the living, organics of our natural world of nature stay in theirs. They can make a digital based simulation seem as real as being in a real world because they are experts at imaging and effects, but they will never in any viable way, mix organic and digital parts to actually act within each other like organic organisms do within themselves.

When we are born into this world, the first thing we experience is the breath of life from the Creator but digital objects can't ever take that first breath. Because the Creator is love itself, in all its aspects, He bestowed upon us His life and breath, with all the endless possibilities of experience and consciousness expansion. This physical dimension is the best world for the beginning of the process of eternal growth and the new and expanding possibilities ahead for his children. The simplicity, logic and common sense test is passed for sure in my estimation.

It is obviously seen that digital creation and organic creation are two different dimensions. To think of the Creator making a world which is organic from a digital based foundation seems like a strange and illogical combination. Humans are good at putting the cart before the horse. Some people view computers and the digital components of computer technology as something the Creator would use as His building blocks. Maybe we think that way because we can't come close to understanding all the aspects of how it was done in an organic, physical way. We keep trying to understand with big bangs and evolution theories and in any other way we can possiblly think of, as long as the Creator is left out of it.

We think, because we have created computers therefore they could be the foundation of all existence. We imagine ourselves as avatars in a video game and, as our world has become addicted to digital screens of TV's, computers, phones etc., it's highly probable that we are digital people. We may be functioning according to the will of a digitally chipped, super-intelligent group of wealthy billionaire computer techs, somewhere up there, where they are never seen by us below, but everything in the life of the humans is affected by them.

Maybe the Creator gave us the knowledge of how to make computers so we could use them, not try to be them! I think it only takes a little bit of logic and

common sense to see the difference. Our minds get deluded by feelings of grandeur as we imagine we are the creators of the universe... because what follows such a grand invention as the computer? ...that we are gods of course. The whole of existence is one big, multi-level video game and we created it! Enough said ...For the sake of simplicity and common sense as well as logic ...did not pass my test!

The next challenge for simplicity, common sense and logic is ... Who is responsible for the evil in the world? The Creator, humans or the devil, who we call Satan?

Who Created Evil?

If we know anything at all about our Creator, we know He is the author of all creativity, goodness, love and peace. He doesn't create evil or destroy anything. He doesn't judge, condemn or send anybody to eternal damnation. Just knowing there is love and kindness in the world proves that truth exists because they are truth within themselves. Common sense and simplicity says that evil and good can't be created together but must always stay on the side of their continuum that defines them. That's why there is a middle line of demarcation between them. If people need growth in lower worlds than the physical dimension, they are always presented with opportunities to change their ways. A God of love would not harm or destroy any of His children. Nature shows us this, as a good and loving father would never harm or destroy their child. How much more is our Creator good and loving to us than an earthly father is? Both allow discipline which can be painful as to avert their child from harming themselves or others even more. With new knowledge of dimensions and portals, it is easier than it used to be to understand how Jesus accomplished this saving of us. Jesus could enter the physical dimension because he was both physical and spiritual at the same time. people of the day that he was special, not just human, but human and divine at the same time and they could be like that too. He had become the 'firstfruits of many sons' in the evolvement of the man with woman toward becoming a being of new substance, a light being, like the Creator Himself.

Jesus's Birth - The Christmas story symbolizes the humbleness of his birth. He came to help us. He said he was a brother and a friend, not a king to lord over us and demand homage of some kind. He wanted us to give praise to the Father of all creation only, not himself.



Jesus's Death - The meaning of his death on the cross was for us to die to the old nature in us that loved the self-gratifying, selfish ways of the world ...to leave behind the physical way of seeing and doing things and become 'renewed' in the mind and become a spiritual oriented person. In this way, we could be prepared to enter the kingdom.

Jesus's Resurrection – When Jesus died and they put him in a tomb, he was dead physically for three days but his spirit, very much alive, went down to lower dimensions and he visited with those who were trapped in those levels also. He wanted them to know that there was a way out for them as well as those above, and if they truly desired it, the kingdom of the Creator was waiting for them to come home also. When he returned from the lower dimensions, he rested in the tomb. He let his body quietly renew itself as the higher spirit within him, and its connection to the Father, brought him back to





Jesus's Ascension — This is the happiest news for us. We can ascend as Jesus did. Thats why Jesus called himself the door and no on could come to the Father except through the door he opens for them. He didn't say we had to believe a certain creed or do certain deeds or perform rituals of any kind. He himself is the portal (Christ Consciousness) that opens to another reality. If we follow him as the 'one who shows the way', we can leave this world through the portal that his

Matt:27: 50-54 ⁵⁰ Jesus, when he had cried again with a loud voice, yielded up the ghost (spirit). ⁵¹ And, behold, the veil of the temple was rent in twain from the top to the bottom; and the earth did quake, and the rocks rent;

⁵² And the graves were opened; and many bodies of the saints which slept arose,

⁵³ And came out of the graves after his resurrection, and went into the holy city, and appeared unto many.

Now when the centurion, and they that were with him, watching Jesus, saw the earthquake, and those things that were done, they feared greatly, saying, Truly this was the Son of God.

In the moment of his death, the dimension of Heaven and the dimension of earth opened to each other and the physical dimension connected with the spiritual realm. For this one moment only, people saw their passed on loved

ones and the angels appeared around them. The Bible says there were thunderings and lightenings and the heavens opened up and exposed themselves to those below. What no one but Jesus knew, was that the portal had opened between the two dimensions just long enough to fulfill the purpose he had come to earth to complete and that purpose was to make himself become that portal.



By the time the universe was restored to some of the order it had before, all quieted down and those who followed him begin grieving his death. Because good needed bad as its counterpart to exist, the Creator used it to discipline and teach His children the penalties for ignoring the laws of the universe and made them stronger within as a result.

Jesus accomplished what needed to be done to eradicate evil by becoming the portal of escape to a higher dimensional reality, hidden behind the facade evil had created. When we awaken to the idea that our consciousness' are all sharing a higher energy field, which is the universe, we realize that we are more than a physical body. thought to them. If they were not aware of the universal life we live together, they would only feel the thought sent to them as depressing, negative or positive and uplifting in some way but not know who sent it and whether it was accidental or intentional.

However, it takes time for us spiritually minded people to realize this. Most of us who are 'awakened' are aware of others' thoughts toward us, but many don't like to think that our thoughts reach those we negated in some way.

Sometimes these thoughts enter our mind so quickly, we don't have time to kick them out. We judge and categorize people all the time. This is why it's a good idea to learn to control our thoughts to only think either 'no thoughts' or 'positive thoughts' about everyone we come in contact with. If we cultivate a 'goodwill feeling' toward everyone we meet, it's more likely to ensure good thoughts to be reciprocated.

Maybe the main reason for quick judgments is because we are too concerned about our own ideas being correct. Did we learn this at school? There is 'right' and 'wrong' everywhere in our school curriculum. If we don't have the 'correct' answer then we are 'wrong''. We won't get an 'A' on the test. By the time we are out of school and in the real world, we have a solid background of knowing the necessity of giving the right answers. So we have to evaluate things quickly and prove without doubt we are right in our premises's otherwise we might lose something important to us.

Sometimes the physical world demands more of us than we feel capable of performing, making it necessary to prove our 'rightness' above anything else. Even when it hurts our loved ones, we stand tall and demand that they surrender to our admonitions of 'rightness'. However, this rightness is not really a belief, it is a vague fear of failure in some way. The unconscious thought is: "If they are right then I am wrong ...conclusion: "I am a failure". I need to be right to feel right about myself ...therefore, I must control outcomes. It takes being right to convince ourselves we are capable of this control. However, this type of cyclic reasoning prevents us from having unconditional acceptance of others and can ruin our relationships.

The newly awakened being sees the difference between life in the physical and life in the spiritual. What mattered before, now has become something to eliminate. What never used to be considered, now has become paramount to receive. It is quite a shift.

Some of us find it hard to trust opening to the universe because, before we were aware of ourselves in it, we felt it was the Creator, Jesus, angels and spiritual guidance 'up there' only. In our physical mind, we thought, because they all love us unconditionally, we were safe in that love no matter how much we messed up. However, when we realize we can no longer feel comfortable in our aloneness and think anything we feel like and no one would ever know, it makes us consider what we want others to 'know' about us. Our ego shivers at the thought that everyone will see our shadows, mistakes and judgments. So wanting others to see us in a good light but also wanting ourselves to be real begins our more introspective search for how to control and change our mind and its contents.

This gathering of beings who resonate with the same intentions and ideals, yet are still growing and changing in the world, demonstrates the need to learn how to relate to each other in the higher minds and let the lower minds take a rest. This control project is difficult and doesn't hide our foilbles much, (what you worry about and want to hide becomes obvious). Since this is hard to accomplish, it takes releasing it to our Creator to help us out. As we try to learn new ways to communicate openly, we realize the importance of being in one accord with our own higher self. Our lower, physical mind doesn't need to be in control anymore because all it does is worry about what others may think of it. We are used to acting how we think we should to make the right impression.

"...be ye transformed by the renewing of your mind."

Some of us have also kept personal spiritual experiences to ourselves and we don't want to share more deeply with others, not liking the idea of being transparent. However, I believe we can get past ourselves and many have already, to find that unconditional love. This brings us closer to the Creator as He is the unconditional love within us. When we desire to change our comfortable habits and step out in faith, He will help us. We don't need continual preparation for what He calls us to do when we have all we need

from within, and if we follow the leading of our inner guidance and helpers, we don't have to worry about outcomes.

It is amazing that when we are aware of this, together we can be a force to reckon with. A force powerful enough, when we send out our creative energy continually, to re-balance the world. People will then be able to continue developing spiritually and move on in the spiritual evolution of humankind. This higher energy frequency can be released all day to multiply as we function in our daily lives.

The enemy of truth and love is trying to stop this development of humans to become higher beings which is the next step in our spiritual and physical evolution. This is why the children, teenagers and young adults are targeted to be distracted from entering the spiritual path in so many ways, even ways we never heard of before.
